



INSTALLATION

1. Lift vehicle and securely place heavy duty jack stands under the manufacturer recommended lifting locations for the front of the vehicle. Take care when lifting the vehicle, and allow 3-4" of ground clearance from the tire. Remove front tires. NEVER WORK UNDER AN UNSUPPORTED VEHICLE.

INSTALLATION. CRASH BAR MOUNTING BOLTS FROM A NON-SASQUATCH BRONCO, OR EQUIVALENT

2. Using a 15mm remove the bolts holding the rear crash bar in. Pull the crash bar out. [FIGURE 1]

1. BRONCOS EQUIPPED WITH SASQUATCH PACKAGE LACK OF HARDWARE NEEDED FOR

METRIC BOLTS, ARE REQUIRED FOR INSTALLATION ONTO A SASQUATCH EQUIPPED BRONCO.



4. To access the front crash bars, the front bumper may need to be loosened. Remove the access cover from the front bumper by firmly gripping it and pulling out. If a sensor is present, be careful not to damage the wiring. [FIGURE 3]

5. Using a 15mm, loosen the 3 bolts holding the bumper to the frame. [FIGURE 4]

6. Using a 15mm loosen and remove the 2 bolts holding the front crash bar in and remove the crash bar. [FIGURE 5]

7. Install the new Icon crash bar into place, the ribs should face the tire and the kick should be up. Install the factory hardware using a small amount of vibratite red thread locker and torque to factory specs. [FIGURE 6]

8. If the front bumper was loosened, tighten those bolts now and reinstall the plastic access cover.

VERIFY ALL FASTENERS ARE PROPERLY TORQUED BEFORE DRIVING VEHICLE. RETORQUE ALL NUTS, BOLTS AND LUGS AFTER 100 MILES AND PERIODICALLY THEREAFTER.
